The Orange County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously Tuesday night to cut off their \$292,000 grant to Planned Parenthood because they “have a problem with government funding of an organization that provides abortion services.” Jon Dunn, President of Planned Parenthood, criticized the vote and accused the board members of acting out of religious beliefs and of being unconcerned for the health of young people in the county. Dunn went on to claim that the move by the board would cause an increase in abortions despite statistics from a Planned Parenthood affiliate in the state of Washington which showed an increase in the number of abortions performed **with** state funding. Let’s hope this begins a new trend and that individuals in every county will approach their local Board of Supervisors to get tax dollars out of the hands of their local Planned Parenthood.

President Obama has announced his plan to reverse protections put in place by President Bush which reinforced the right of health care professionals to refuse to perform abortions if it violates their conscience or moral beliefs. If this takes effect, pro-life medical centers, hospitals and staff members will soon have that right taken away. By law, this regulation change proposal is open to public comment for 30 days. Anyone wishing to submit a comment may send an email to proposedrescission@hhs.gov, but it must be sent within the next 3 weeks. Comments should be from health care professionals and should include instances of when medical professionals have been pressured into participating in an abortion, whether you feel the Bush protections are a good idea, and should include language that shows the claim made by pro-aborts that protecting the right of health care professionals will hurt access to health care is unfounded.

Komen for the Cure & Planned Parenthood:

The Coalition on Abortion/Breast Cancer, a watchdog group that exposes the link between abortion and breast cancer, has released a new video that exposes the relationship between Susan G. Komen for the Cure and Planned Parenthood. According to the group, Komen chapters gave \$711,485 to Planned Parenthood affiliates in just one year and 25 Komen affiliates now have a partnership with the abortion business. The video reports on the cover-up of the abortion-breast cancer link and explains the biological explanation behind the link as well as how abortion advocates and cancer groups are preventing women from getting the information.
