FRONT ROYAL, Virginia, October 3, 2011 (LifeSiteNews.com) [The Population Research Institute](http://LifeSiteNews.com) (PRI) has released the latest episode of their popular YouTube cartoon series. The series is designed to refute the idea of overpopulation with stick figure animation.

The latest video, available at Overpopulationisamyth.com deals with the issues surrounding our population's latest milestone of 7 billion people. The video aims to show that, according to the UN's latest data, the world's population is not skyrocketing out of control, but rather slowing to a standstill before plummeting downward again.

"We set out to be entertaining first," says Colin Mason, PRI's Director of Media Production and the video's editor. "We figure if we can be funny and interesting visually, people will absorb the concepts."

"Essentially," Mason continued, "when people see the rate at which we're adding a billion people, they automatically assume that our population is ballooning at an unsustainable rate. But that's not the case at all...and most of the time, all it takes is a simple explanation of the math and people get it. The hard part is getting them interested enough to do that. That's what we hope to accomplish with these videos."

"The fight against the myth of overpopulation does not have to be a bare-knuckled brawl," says Steven Mosher, PRI's president. "These videos are funny and easy to digest, the very opposite of Al Gore's boring pronouncements on the 'dangers' of too many people. Our viewers end up considering the science that supports our pro-people position, often for the very first time. We say to our skeptics: watch, laugh, and learn."

MILWAUKEE, Wisconsin, November 3, 2011 (LifeSiteNews.com) Witnesses outside an abortion clinic said an African-American girl who looked to be between 11 and 14 years old had asked for help from pro-life sidewalk counselors, only to be physically blocked by the abortion clinic escort staff. The girl was trying to get more information at a pro-life center across the street.

"Once she said she wanted to go across the street, she [the escort] held up her arm and blocked her, then she put her hand on the kid's shoulder to stop her," said one of the counselors present at the scene. "The whole group of vigilers were pleading for her to let her go across the street to get free help, and they wouldn't let her."

"We could hear her say, 'please take your hands off me,'" one of the counselors reported. "You could see it in her eyes." The counselor went on to say that the guardian, who appeared to be the girl's mother, came out of the clinic appearing "very irritated" and "literally pulled her back into the clinic."

When the police were called, the operator responded by saying there was nothing to be done, and no officers were dispatched.

[The Justice Foundation](http://TheJusticeFoundation) has a [letter](#) that can be printed out and given to the parents or guardians of a pregnant minor which outlines the rights of the minor. It states that no one may force, coerce, or pressure her to have an abortion. It also gives examples of coercion, such as threatening to kick the girl out of the house, grounding unless she has the abortion, or threatening her with violence.

If you know a girl who is pregnant and being pressured by someone, please give her the letter so she will know what her rights are.

My heart is broken. No, shattered. And the pieces are so very small that I am afraid that I will be unable to gather them back together again. What is happening in our world? In our country.....our state....our city....our homes? Children are dying...from abortion....from abuse....from neglect. And so many of us are turning a blind eye. We profess with our lips love and tolerance and yet our hands strike out in anger and we close our eyes to the horror happening around us. I want to gather all of these children in my arms and hold them to myself. I want to softly whisper words of love and encouragement to them. I want to dry their tears and stroke their head and gently rock them to sleep. I want to wrap them all up in a blanket overflowing with love and let them know how special they are. I want to tell them they are children of God, loved with a love that surpasses all understanding.

I read so many articles in order to write the quarterly newsletter and so many of them are heartbreaking. On occasion, I cry. The tears sting as they roll down my cheeks. Women are being forced to have abortions. It doesn't only happen in China. It happens right here when boyfriends threaten their girlfriends with leaving or abuse if they don't abort. It happens when parents threaten their daughters with eviction or abandonment and force them to the abortion clinic. The many years of abortion and birth control have turned children into an object....*a thing*. *Something* that we can choose to have or to throw away.

I don't write this as someone who believes herself to be above all that ails us, but rather as someone who has suffered the same temptations and, by the grace of God, has come to realize my numerous faults and shortcomings. I myself was unexpectedly pregnant at the age of 18 and had decided to have an abortion. Thankfully, a coworker who had made that "choice" and deeply regretted it shared her experience with me and my mind was changed not only for that moment but for the rest of my life. My son is now 24 years old and I would be blessed with three more children over the course of the next 15 years.

I would like to propose something. That we love and treasure our children. That we show them how loved and valued they are. Not only with words, but with actions. I propose that we "occupy Love". Or rather, that we allow Love to occupy us. Let it wash over us and send all that is keeping us cold and distant from one another down the drain. Allow love to overcome us and transform us. Let's allow Love to direct us in its symphony. Let's allow compassion to become the law of the land and have mercy not be what we seek for ourselves, but for others as well. Let's have Christmas be a season that rejuvenates our hearts, our minds, and our lives and leads us closer to God by bringing us closer to one another. And as we celebrate the birth of the infant Jesus more than 2,000 years ago, let us be reminded that children are indeed a gift from God.
